Plan for New, Improved Holiday Benefit

After the recent success of our Holiday Benefit, chairperson Kathy Seidl wondered "How can we make this even better?" Of course, she had a ready answer – "Split it up into two events!" The Board discussed the idea at the February Board meeting and thought it sounded like a great idea. One event will be held September 27 in the evening, so husbands and business professionals can attend. It will include a dinner, a bar, a Silent Auction, an Oral Auction, and an Angel Donation request. It would likely draw a crowd of 500-600 people. The second event will remain a daytime event. It will be in May, 2012, around Mother's Day. It will be a themed Mother's Day event, with a luncheon or a tea, a style show, a raffle of four baskets, and a quilt made by Linda Rakow (who has agreed to make one for the evening event, as well). This might draw a crowd of 300-400 people. There would NOT be an auction or an angel donation. Linda Brammer and Marcia Auger are co-chairpersons for this event.

Change in Membership Renewal Form

There will be a change in our membership renewal form this year. This notice is to explain the reason for the change. It deals with our contribution to National CCS. Each Chapter has an obligation to financially support National CCS. We do this by assessing each member an additional \$7.00 for National membership dues in addition to our local Chapter dues. Later in the year, we are sent an invitation from National to donate to the "Annual Giving Appeal." It is very confusing to most members because it seems voluntary. The reality is, if we as individuals do not pay the \$20 minimum, our Chapter is responsible for that amount per member to National.

We must realize that to be a member of CCS South Bend, we are also members of National CCS. Our obligation is to both. We list 497 members for which we are assessed the National fees. Some of our members help in the Center, others help with fundraising. To be a member of Christ Child means we will help in some way. The one thing we all should make every effort to do is to pay ALL of our dues, so it doesn't become a burden to our local Chapter. Last year the unpaid National fees cost our local Chapter \$10,000.00. Please don't underestimate the value of your financial participation, whether you are an active or inactive member of our chapter.

In an effort to simplify the membership renewal, and to more clearly list the fees, we've added the cost of the National dues and Chapter Support to the new renewal form. You will have the option to pay your local dues \$35.00 for seniors, or \$40.00 regular, plus the National dues of \$7.00, AND the Chapter Support of \$20.00 for a total of \$62.00 (or \$67.00). We will keep track of the dues and Chapter Support payments and notify National so that you will receive credit. This will be of tremendous benefit to our local Chapter. Let's keep our local dues HERE, helping our Center with operation expenses. You wouldn't be in The Christ Child Society if you didn't have a heart of gold! Thank you for your cooperation with this.

St. Joseph Seventh Graders

The Clothing Center is a busy place. It is the heartbeat of The Christ Child Society. Everyone who comes to work finds a job, and before they leave, they have a sense of satisfaction and accomplishment.

I would imagine the same would apply to a very special young group of volunteers who come to the Center every Wednesday. They come without being asked, without ever missing a Wednesday, without waiting to be thanked, doing whatever is asked of them.

I'm talking about the 7th grade volunteers from St. Joseph Grade School in South Bend. It is part of a program which is very well organized, and is part of the 7th graders' preparation for Confirmation by performing community service hours. There is a schedule of parents who volunteer to drive the students, in groups of four, to and from the Center every Wednesday. The students sign in on the volunteer sheet, are given a tour of the Center, and then put to work. For the next couple of hours, they sort used clothes, de-tag and bag jackets for storage, restock clothing, haul bins from here to there, stuff envelopes, anything and everything.

I don't know how many members were aware of these young helpers, but I thought it was high time we give a big "shout out" to St. Joseph South Bend Seventh Graders! Thank you, students, for all you have done for The Christ Child Society.

"I give all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to The Christ Child Society, Inc. of South Bend, IN, General Fund."
