Center Sponsors Dental Health Month

The level of oral health affects the entire body. Yet many aren't aware of the proper techniques of brushing or the importance of flossing. Because of this, Christ Child Society of South Bend is having a Dental Health Program at the Center the month of October during Wednesday hours.

Dental Hygiene students from IUSB will be at the Center to give demonstrations and information about dental health. Representatives from IVY Tech will also be present, registering families for free Saturday appointments at their clinic. The appointments will include:teeth cleaning, oral hygiene instruction, xrays, fluoride treatment, dental sealants and an exam by a dentist.

We are in the process of contacting local dentists and dental associations for monetary contributions to underwrite the cost of purchasing toothbrush/ tooth paste/ floss packages to be dispersed to the needy children we serve.

We will be hosting them on October 30th and November 6th hoping not only to give the pastors a chance to know more about Christ Child Society but hopefully they will bring members of their staff who may help us promote used clothing drives or opportunities for their students to get involved.

Report from the Board Meeting

Since our opening day of August 14, this year we have served 587 families and 1483 children. This is an increase of 76 families and 130 children over this time last year.
